

6. Collaboration for organizing National and International Seminars, Conferences and Guest Lectures:

Both the institutions will collaborate for organizing National and International Seminars, Conferences and workshops and guest lectures. At least one International and one National level seminar will be organized in an academic year with joint collaboration.

7. Collaborating for organizing B-School Meets:

Both the institutes will join together in organizing Business School Meets by utilizing the best available in-house facilities and by involving students and faculty members.

8. Conduct of Job Fairs:

The Training and Placement Cells of the institutes will join together for organizing job fairs. The existing and pass out students of both the institutions will be able to get maximum exposure to the placement opportunities.

9. Skill Development Programs:

Both the institutes will join together in organizing training programs for the students on emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.

- Academic Excellence: Further, we will extend the areas of collaboration for strengthening the academic excellence.
- Financial commitment: There is no financial commitment on the part of both the institutions and if there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.
- Validity: This agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either party on mutually agreed terms.


